LES 2 ALPES: INTRODUCTION

Skiing is the driving force behind French mountain tourism and the number 1 reason that holidaymakers come to winter resorts! France is Europe's top skiing area and the number ONE skiing destination in the world in front of the United States and Austria. France is home to 325 ski resorts, including the dynamic, sporty, international, trendy and innovative resort of Les 2 Alpes. The resort, situated in the lsere region, numbers among the major wintersports resorts with 1,179,536 skier days (53.9 million across the French mountains) and is listed in the TOP 10! The resort's major asset is its natural snowfall from the first to the last day of the season, thanks to its glacier at 3,600 metres, as well as FREESTYLE LAND (a paradise for new snowsports), the easily accessible glacier, the resort's human-scale which means everything is within reach, doorstep skiing, a blue run between 3,400 and 1,600 metres, reliable ski lifts, modern and funky shopping, oodles of activities and entertainment, a party atmosphere, quality gastronomy (68 restaurants) and a philosophy of always moving forward in terms of equipment, services, and events... Les 2 Alpes also bears labels certifying the privileged welcome it extends to families (FAMILY PLUS), the faultless welcome it provides to all holidaymakers (QUALITY TOURISM), and the quality of its apartments with LES 2 ALPES QUALITY accommodation label.

CREATION OF THE NEW "LES DEUX ALPES" MUNICIPALITY

After many months of work, deliberation, public meetings, polling and evaluation, on Thursday the 23rd of June 2016, the Mont de Lans and Venosc municipal councils simultaneously and unanimously voted for the creation of a new "Les 2 Alpes" municipality.

The joint decision of the two municipal councils was delivered to the Isère department authorities, who will pass legislation creating the new "Les Deux Alpes" municipality before the 30th of September. It will officially see the light of day on January 1st 2017, when the new Deux Alpes municipality will truly come into being. A charter defining its major political principles and how it will function was voted in by both municipal councils, outlining plans to alternate shared governance until 2020 and to keep the historic municipalities of Mont de Lans and Venosc functioning as delegate municipalities.

. th a little over 2,000 inhabitants, its administrative centre will be in the resort of Les 2 Alpes and its main town hall will be located at 48 Avenue de la Muzelle 38860 Les Deux Alpes (a former branch of the Mont de Lans town hall). The Mont de Lans and Venosc village town halls will remain.

Until 2020, the new municipality will be run by a municipal council composed of all of the municipal councillors from both Mont de Lans and Venosc. After the 1st of January 2017, they will become preserved and fairly represented delegate municipalities, pursuing matters of investment and business projects.

This merger is a strong, unifying decision for investment and for tackling important issues that arise, such as renewing the ski lift public utilities contract, liaising with the resort of Alpe d'Huez, and developing use of artificial snow using Lake Mura as a water supply....

The new municipality will provide its citizens with continuity in quality public services and will lead to joint savings and greater efficiency.

Local councillors approach this new merger with confidence and hope for a new era of progress for the resort of Les 2 Alpes, as well as the Romanche and Vénéon valleys.

Also, maintenance work is being carried out on the run (general appearance, water run-off zones...) and vegetation planted along the sides to conserve biodiversity, protect the environment and erase traces of building work on the mountainside so the area can return to being 90% green in the next two years.

LES 2 ALPES, A LARGE FRENCH SKI AREA

LES 2 ALPES SKI AREA DESCRIPTION

The ski area covers **415 hectares** (200km) between altitudes of 1,300 metres (Mont de Lans) and 3,600 metres (the glacier). 60% of the resort's runs are aimed at beginners and intermediate skiers and 40% are aimed at experienced and expert skiers. One of Les 2 Alpes' special characteristics is that "the higher you go, the easier the runs are", making the glacier ideal for beginners. 25% of the resort's visitors are snowboarders (national average: 10%). Les 2 Alpes was the first ski resort to enable snowboarders to use all of their ski lifts, including ski tows. Before that, they had to get around using snow-scooters!!! The runs are divided into 5 sectors: Mont de Lans (1,300 metres), Vallée Blanche (2,100 m), Les Crêtes (2, 100 m), La Fée (2,600 m) and the glacier between 2,900 and 3,600 metres.

+ The longest vertical drop in the world (Le Parisien newspaper): 2,300 metres of vertical drop from the glacier (3,600 m) to the village of Mont-de-Lans (1,300 m), without using ski lifts!

→ Guaranteed DOORSTEP SKIING access in and out of the resort! The runs and ski lifts work together from the resort entrance to the other end of the plateau (flat profile) and consequently, clients can enjoy direct access to ski runs and ski lifts to get up to the higher summits, straight from their accommodation.

GUARANTEED SNOW IN LES 2 ALPES!

Les 2 Alpes means the promise of natural snow from the start to the end of the season, thanks to the glacier at an altitude of 3,600 metres. Skiability is ensured by high mountain summits, snow cannons installed at the bottom of the slopes between 1,300 and 2,100 metres and SNOW-TRAPPING techniques (stockpiling snow using wooden barriers or a series of half-tubes dug into the glacier, the snow from which is then spread over the ski area, glacier and lower runs every day by piste groomer).

• Eirst snowfall: October half term (25th of October to the 2nd of November) is an opportunity to put your skis back on and leave the first tracks of the season on the glacier.

• Last snowfall: Spring is a mild period in terms of temperature, and the days are longer. Careful slope maintenance, which is even more challenging in spring, and the high mountain summits guarantee quality snow, making "springtime skiing" a real season in Les 2 Alpes!!!

FREESTYLE "LES 2 ALPES FREESTYLE LAND": NEW SNOWSPORTS FOR EVERYONE...

Snowsports have been in Les 2 Alpes' DNA since the 90s. The MONDIAL DU SNOWBOARD et DU SKI event contributed to its reputation and the facilities have improved year on year to meet the needs of pros and the general public. Today, the FREESTYLE area known as 2 ALPES FREESTYLE LAND boasts a snowpark for pros (slopestyle, big air, rails...) and fun zones for everybody, redesigned and improved for 2016! (Easy park, progress park, kids' park, family park...).

At 3,200 metres / GLACIER sector - 1 HALF PIPE (the same module as in summer – open in March and April)

At 2,600 metres / TOURA sector

- EASY PARK: easy FREESTYLE area boasting banked turns, a mini pipe, mini rails, moguls and tables custom-made for budding Freestylers.
- PROGRESS PARK: for beginners and those looking to progress in Freestyle.
- FAMILY PARK: course featuring banked turns, moguls, whoops... A challenge to enjoy with friends or family!
- PARK AVENUE: area reserved for JIB, an urban environment where the modules are made from former bus shelters, cable car cabins and ramps (20).
- SLOPESTYLE: a series of 4 tables gently transitioning into one another with fantastic approach runs.
- PARK DE L'ENVERS: a medium-sized table, a more demanding table, rail lines of all levels... A whole area for working on tricks.
- COOL ZONE: a rest area between the runs and get-togethers with deck chairs, music, BBQ and equipment.

At 2,100 metres / Les CRÊTES sector

A KIDS PARK at Les CRÊTES at 2,100 metres (Les Ancontres) where children can get a feel for Freestyle.

At 1,600 metres / FOOT OF THE SLOPES - SNOW FRONT sector

A SNOWPARK AREA on the Limaçons snow front (Open at night from Tuesday to Friday and in the event of bad weather: a mogul and 2 rail lines).

A VAST FREERIDE AREA

800 hectares of off-piste zones: Chalance, La Fée, Les Vallons du Diable, Les Posettes, Bellecombes, La Selle... Leave your tracks in untouched snow whilst remaining aware of safety risks. Due to the effort, incline and altitude difference, make sure you go with a professional. (Weekly FREERIDE ATTITUDE events; as well as the "DVA/A.R.V.A – Nivology" training offered by the mountain guides' office.)

• Les VALLONS DE LA SELLE: 2,100 metres of vertical drop and 7 kilometres of descent on Les Aiguilles de la Selle – Set off from the Dôme de la Lauze (3,568 metres) and arrive at the village of St Christophe, then enjoy a snack at La Cordée bar restaurant (authentic location). Return by bus to the village of Venosc, before taking a gondola lift back to Les 2 Alpes.

→ La **MEUE**: The resort of Les 2 Alpes is connected to the VALLONS DE LA MEUE via its summits (3,600 metres). La Meije is a legendary 3,982-metre peak. It is an international must-visit destination for FREERIDE fans... 2,150 metres of vertical drop to hurtle down, preferably accompanied by a guide or a high mountain professional.

◆ A DVA PARK, situated in the Toura sector at the top of the Bellecombes chair lift, a free way of learning how to use and handle DVA (Avalanche Victim Detector) equipment before venturing off-piste.

PROFESSIONALLY SUPERVISED SKIING ...

400 instructors teach skiing and offer lessons for all ability levels, in all disciplines and in some ten different languages. As well as the lessons on offer, it gives you a chance to be accompanied around the slopes whilst exploring the ski area. Fans of competition can test their mettle against champions by taking part in the weekly Chamois and Flèche TRIALS. The instructors are keen to convey their passion for snowsports to everyone, including those with reduced mobility or sight-impairment, thanks to specialist instructors and specially adapted equipment.

+ LESSONS JUST FOR TEENS – The fun of skiing with friends, meeting people, sharing and discovering all kinds of snowsports according to the conditions and your preferences!

• SNOWBOARDING BENEATH THE STARS – Enjoy skiing during the day and learning how to snowboard at night. One evening a week, combine skiing and snowboarding (Mondays from 5.30pm to $7pm / 20 \in$).

DISCOVER THE SKI AREA – For intermediate-level skiers, every Sunday afternoon (2.30pm to 5pm / 35€)

SNOWBOARDING LESSONS FOR KIDS – School holidays only, a mini beginners' group snowboarding lesson for children between the ages of 6 and 8 (3 sessions of 90 mins / 5 students max).

NEW ACTIVITIES

- WATCH THE SUNSET FROM A PISTE GROOMER: When the slopes close for the day, climb the high mountain summits from 2,600 metres to 3,600 metres aboard a piste groomer, and discover a unique experience with mountain professionals as the sun sets! Enjoy petit fours and champagne as you watch the sunset and gaze over the unique 360° mountain views!
- Les ECRINS VIEWING POINT, 3,400 metres up: wow yourself with an even better look at the unique 360° panoramic view from the glacier at this new viewing point (similar to a skywalk), created at 3,400 metres (Soreiller summit)!
- SLOW ZONE OR PEACEFUL SKIING! From the glacier at 3,400 metres, back down to the resort, just follow the "Peaceful Skiing, Slow Zone" signs denoting the
 "responsible skiing" area, which is regularly patrolled by ski patrollers. Dedicated to peaceful snowsports, the watchwords here are moderate speed and
 respectful behaviour.
- "2 ALPES ACADEMY" offers instruction in PROPER CHAIR LIFT CONDUCT! As part of the National awareness campaign relating to proper usage of chair lifts, DEUX ALPES LOISIRS (ski lift company) and the E.S.F. French Ski School are running "how to use a chair lift" workshops throughout the winter. The idea is to understand how to get on and off correctly, and to revise good conduct when using a chair lift. Meet at the "Alpette" chair lift (bottom of the slopes) on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings (free of charge). Attendees will receive a certificate at the end of the session.
- FIRST TRACKS SKIING = DISCOVER THE JOB OF A SKI PATROLLER! Every Wednesday morning discover the day-to-day life of a Les 2 Alpes ski patroller: work stations, daily routine, keeping the slopes safe, client information, rescue, dog-handling, avalanche blasting, opening the ski runs for the day... A rare opportunity to share in the early hours of the morning. Meet at the "Jandri Express" gondola lift at 8am and enjoy breakfast at the Le 3200 restaurant at 11am.
- Off-piste skiing awareness with FREERIDE ATTITUDE: For 17 years, the resort has been keeping visitors informed about off-piste skiing with FREERIDE ATTITUDE. This weekly (Tuesday) free event is an awareness workshop about the risks involved in going off-piste. Presentation and guidance on handling safety equipment (DVA avalanche beacon, shovel, probe), Q&A sessions, debates, and professionally supervised Freeride sessions.
- SKI TOURING at night: The mountain guides office offers ski touring beginners the chance to take part in an unmissable adventure in Les 2 Alpes, climbing beneath the stars whilst wearing a head-torch! A range of sessions are available for different abilities, with the option of having dinner in the mountains! After a tasty break, take your sealskins off and gently ski back to the resort.
- E FAT BIKING on snow: Les 2 Alpes mountain guides and mountain leaders office is one of the first organisations in France to offer guided electrically assisted mountain biking on snow (Full day, ½ day and even at night)!, everyone always comes back smiling ear to ear! An absolute must-try!
- HELICOPTER FLIGHTS: first flights above Les 2 Alpes' summits or ski in the resort of Alpe d'Huez; the Les 2 Alpes experience really comes to life in the air!
- SPEEDRIDING: A discipline combining skiing and paragliding... Tease the powder snow just a few centimetres above the ground on Les 2 Alpes' off-piste area...
- MOUNTAIN BIKING: Exceptional, mountain biking on the Venosc run (700 metres of vertical drop) from mid-April to 29th April, when the resort closes.
- BIG AIR BAG: 15 x 11 metre mattress where you do freestyle jumps without hurting yourself... Supervised by professionally qualified ski instructors.
- RUISSELING: climb frozen rivers with the help of special crampons... An unusual hike and a beautiful discovery!!!

VARIED ACTIVITIES

PARAGLIDING (first flight with an instructor on skis over Les 2 Alpes – 3 schools) – **SKI TOURING** - **SNOW-SHOEING** at night and during the day / sporting, discovery, family, gourmet, night-time sessions... (Mountain Guides Office) – **WINE-TASTING SPORTS EVENINGS** (wine-tasting + dinner at Le Diable au Coeur, then ski back to the resort supervised by the E.S.F. French Ski School) – **SNOWMOBILING** (every evening at 6pm) – **HORSE-DRAWN CARRIAGE RIDES** (rides take place on the snow front and go to La Molière) – **DOG-SLEDDING** – **THE VILLAGES OF VENOSC AND MONT DE LANS** (accessible by ski lift) – **SWIMMING POOL AND ICE RINK** in the resort centre (free with a 2-day or longer skipass), **ICE GROTTO** (at the foot of the glacier at an altitude of 3,200 metres, many different sculptures...) - **ROBOCOASTER** (An articulated 7-metre long simulator, with 3D images letting you experience the sensation of being in an avalanche; a fun way of raising awareness of off-piste skiing). VENOSC and MONT DE LANS, the villages that make up Les 2 Alpes

VENOSC : This traditional Oisans region mountain village nestles at the heart of the Vénéon Valley. Its narrow, cobbled streets, age-old old rustic houses, 14th century bell tower, 17th century altarpiece, chapels and fountains are witness to centuries of mountain life and offer a complete change of scenery that is a perfect gentle après-ski activity. Artisans and artists (ceramics, silks, wood, miniatures, leather, fabric, jewellery, gastronomy, honey, wine), who fell in love with this authentic and rustic setting, are also to be found in Venosc to the delight of its visitors.

MONT DE LANS: Situated at an altitude of 1,300 metres, Mont de Lans is the last village you go through before arriving at the resort of Les 2 Alpes. Through the centuries, it has welcomed a huge number of tourists to see the historical objects on display at the Chazal Lento museum. Not content with just receiving visitors, Mont de Lans sent its children out to travel all over France and the world as pedlars. The "Chazal Lento" museum evokes memories of the past.

AS WELL AS

- WELL-BEING: 10 SPA and well-being areas in beauty salons, hotels and complexes. Whirlpool baths, steam rooms, saunas, oxygen isolation tanks, slimming treatments, massages, relaxation, gym, body-building, fitness, cardio-training, sun lounges and sun beds... As well as aqua-gym, shiatsu aromatherapy (essential oils)...
- SHOPPING: a 2-kilometre long avenue lined with shops, bars, restaurants, flavours, interior decor... Browse on foot, or take a horse-drawn carriage or free shuttle bus. The resort shows off its trendy, fashionable side with brands such as Billabong, Quiksilver, Northface, DC Shoes, Burton, Oxbow, Oakley, Volcom, Rip Curl, Shred... Daring style can also to be found in the resort's boutiques specialising in women's wear, jewellery, underwear,...
- QUALITY GASTRONOMY: You'll find 68 restaurants in Les 2 Alpes with cuisine as varied as it is refined: traditional, mountain, Italian, Corsican, Moroccan, English, Breton, gastronomic... Resort restaurants, takeaways, slopeside restaurants, as well as well-known gourmet haunts such as the P'TIT POLYTE (1 Michelin star) and the DIABLE AU CŒUR (awarded the title of MASTER RESTAURATEUR), not forgetting le RAISIN D'OURS, a bistronomic restaurant and holder of the Michelin Guide's Fourchette award.





The resort of Les 2 Alpes makes a special point of welcoming children and their families. In 2009, the resort acquired the FAMILY PLUS MOUNTAIN label that guarantees children on winter sports holidays in Les 2 Alpes a special welcome and quality facilities. (Label charter: children from the age of 6 months welcomed to the childcare centre, little ones pampered by professionals, entertainment adapted to all ages, quality facilities, a nearby medical service for little bumps and grazes, family pricing policy) Today, 116 tourist destinations have received the Family Plus label across the following territories: Sea (46), Mountains (43), Towns (6) and Countryside (21).

CHILDCARE FACILITIES

The "BONHOMME DE NEIGE" (SNOWMAN) centre, at the heart of the resort, is home to 3 childcare facilities: a crèche, a nursery, and a leisure centre. The crèche welcomes children from the age of 6 months, with childcare carried out by early years professionals. The nursery takes care of children between the ages of 2 and 6 years. Older children will find plenty to occupy them in the leisure centre, including snowshoeing hikes, swimming, skiing, group games...

SKIING

SKIING FROM THE AGE OF 3

Learning to ski begins at the age of 3 in the resort's 3 snow kindergartens. Equipped with educational games, ski tows and a magic carpet (40 metres long, enabling children to get to the top of the snow kindergarten, on skis or a snowboard). Les 2 Alpes' ESF French Ski School snow kindergarten uses the PIOU PIOU concept, which lets young skiers move around and glide on the snow whilst having fun! For older children, specially adapted lessons (skiing or snowboarding) are available to suit their ability level, and at the end of the week, they'll be awarded one of our famous stars.

**** KIDS' PARK

Aimed at introducing 8 to 10 year olds to the joys and techniques of Freestyle skiing, this protected ski area is perfectly adapted to children (located on the CRÊTES sector). Comprising a ski lift, moguls and elevated turns to learn how to perform jumps.

LES "PETITES CRÊTES", AN IDEAL PLACE FOR CHILDREN

This specially demarcated zone is perfect for young beginner skiers, equipped with a hi-tech magic carpet (The "SUNKID" - 250 metres long, covered by an ultra-modern glass and metal structure offering panoramic views).

▶ THE "BABYSNOW"; A SNOWSPORTS DEVICE FOR TINY TOTS...

In 2010, Les 2 Alpes launched a new snowsports device: the BABYSNOW. Designed by a ski instructor/high mountain guide from Les 2 Alpes, it is a type of snow scooter for children between the ages of 1 and 4 which can be used on a snowshoe hike, when out walking, and above all when you are skiing.
